FAQ: How to use the video player

To play the videos:

- Make sure your computer's sound is turned on before viewing the videos
- Go to the link of the video, or chapter of a video, that you want to watch and click on it
- Due to varying quality of internet connectivity, you may need to: 1) start the video 2) then click on the pause button and <u>wait for up to 10 minutes</u> before initially playing the video to allow it to fully load



To skip to a specific chapter while watching the videos:
