1. Missing the new open enrollment when Social Security Disability beneficiaries turn 65



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2. Failure to appeal income- adjusted premiums



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3. Limitations on:

- Welcome to Medicare Physical
- Annual Wellness Visit



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4. Impact of signing ABN (Advance Beneficiary Notice of Non Coverage)



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5. Failure to verify inpatient status during a hospital stay



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6. Failure to submit charges for drugs administered during “observation” to Part D plan



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7. Failure to set up and utilize MyMedicare.gov – online health care management tool



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8. Failure to review and compare Part D Prescription plans and Part C Advantage plans during annual open enrollment
